



## **Pre-K socialization and academic readiness goals**

### **Reading goals:**

1. Read aloud to children daily
2. Read the Bible, stories and children's classics
3. Teach the different parts of a book, author, illustrator
4. Letter recognition and letter-sound association
5. Recognize own name, names of other sight words, etc...
6. Pre-reading skills of front to back, left to right, top to bottom, real or pretend
7. Recite the alphabet

### **Math goals:**

1. Basic shapes (recognize then reproduce)
2. Matching (same and different)
3. One to One correspondence
4. Categorizing (size, shape and color)
5. Count by rote to 30 and understand numeric content
6. Matching sets
7. Recognize numerals
8. Learn eight basic colors
9. Work puzzles of 10-14+ pieces

### **By the end of the preschool year we hope children can:**

1. Listen attentively for 20 minutes
2. Follow a two or three step direction
3. Show responsibility in caring for personal belongings
4. Verbalize needs: bathroom, illness, ask for directions
5. Display familiarization with letter and number concepts
6. Make appropriate choices during centers and play times
7. Attend to complete brief, individual work activities

### **Children should develop a sense of belonging to a group by:**

1. Taking turns and sharing toys and learning materials
2. Listening while others speak
3. Following directions
4. Interacting with other children during work and play situations in a positive and thoughtful manner
